Addendum Report

Thank you for your letter dated 28th November 2019 regarding this client. I also received the hospital records on 9th November 2019. I have been asked to produce this addendum report after the review of the updated medical records.

I am able to state that I saw this client for a medico-legal report on 1st October 2018. In addition to other problems the left knee joint was causing him a lot of grief. He suffered with left knee problems due to anterior cruciate ligament previously. As a result of this injury the client had arthroscopy examination of the left knee joint at Surry Nuffield Hospital on 13th June 2019. The operating notes suggested that the client had examination of the knee under anaesthetic.

1. It was recorded that there was a bucket handle type of tear which is related with the accident.
2. Some changes in the patellar femoral joint.
3. Medial plica was noted which is a coincidental finding and usually the plica is congenital.
4. The client was operated upon as a day case and was sent home on the same day.
5. The client was advised that the sutures should be removed after 10 days and physiotherapy treatment will start.
6. After the operation the client was seen on 18th July 2019. It was described that the symptoms were due to bucket handle tear as a result of the injury to the medial meniscus. This was as a result of the accident on 20th April 2018. He was advised to wear good footwear and was discharged from the clinic.




In my opinion the client was expected to recover from the symptoms in the left knee joint due to the accident by September 2019 without any disability. As a result of the accident no further complications were expected.

I trust I have clarified the position. Please let me know if I can be of any further assistance.
